Victoria High School Dual Credit Course Offerings

English Composition I - For Seniors only. Offered 1st Semester each year. Taught by Mrs. RuthAnnZimmer. 3 Credit Course. Students must receive at least a 20 on the English portion of the ACT test or at least a 255 on BOTH the Sentence Skills and the Reading portion of the Accuplacer Test. Offered through NCKTC.

English Composition II - For Seniors only. Offered 2nd Semester each year. Taught by Mrs. RuthAnn Zimmer. 3 Credit Course. Students must have taken English Composition I for college credit and must have successfully passed with a C or better. Offered through NCKTC.

Speech / Oral Communications - For Sophomores through Seniors. Offered only one semester each year. Taught by Mrs. RuthAnn Zimmer. 3 Credit Course. No prerequisites for this course. Offered through NCKTC.

Psychology - For Juniors and Seniors. Offered first semester each year. Taught by Mrs. Christie Sander. 3 Credit Course. No prerequisites for this course. Offered through NCKTC.

Sociology - For Juniors and Seniors. Offered second semester each year. Taught by Mrs. Christie Sander. 3 Credit Course. No prerequisites for this course. Offered through NCKTC.

Computer Applications - For Sophomores through Seniors. Offered two semesters each year. Taught by Mr. Ken Schoenrock. 3 Credit Course. No prerequisites for this course. Offered through NCKTC.

Intermediate Algebra - For Juniors and Seniors. Offered 1 Semester each year. Facilitated by Ms. Samantha Voorhees 3 Credit Course. Students must receive at least an 18 on the English portion of the ACT test or at least a 250 on Math portion of the Accuplacer Test. Because this course is taught online, there is an additional cost for both, the course and the book. Please see Mrs. Kori Braun or Miss Sam Voorhees for more details. Offered through NCKTC.

College Algebra - For Juniors and Seniors. Offered 1 Semester each year. Facilitated by Ms. Samantha Voorhees 3 Credit Course. Students must receive at least a 22 on the English portion of the ACT test or at least a 263 on Math portion of the Accuplacer Test. OR, if the student took Intermediate Algebra for college credit and received a C or better they will qualify. Offered through Colby Community College.

Statistics - For Juniors and Seniors. Offered 1 Semester each year. Facilitated by Ms. Samantha Voorhees 3 Credit Course. Students must have taken College Algebra for College Credit and received a C or better in order to take this course. Offered through Colby Community College.
